

XV INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR EX LIBRIS GLIWICE-CIESZYN 2026

DETAILED INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF PERSONS APPLYING TO THE COMPETITION

In connection with the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC, the Organizers inform that:

1. Personal Data Administrators are:

 - University of Silesia in Katowice with headquarters by the Bankowa Street 12, 40-007 Katowice,
2. Clarifications regarding matters related to personal data will be provided by the Personal Data:

3. Personal data will be processed for purposes related to the organization and conduct of the competition, including: identification of participants, attribution of authorship of the work, communication, selection and public announcement of the winners, preparation of a post-competition publication, and the awarding, delivery, collection, and settlement of the competition. The legal basis for the processing of personal data for the above purpose is the participant's consent, in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.
4. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the organization and conduct of the competition, the receipt of the prize, and the transfer of copyright.
5. Personal data in the form of an image (including voice, if recorded) will be processed for the purposes of promoting the Competition in connection with the preparation of audiovisual documentation, on the basis of Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR — processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest in connection with the statutory duties of the Organizers and Partners of the Competition. The dissemination of the image will be carried out pursuant to Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of 6 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights.
6. Personal data in the form of an image or voice may be transferred to a third country. Recipients of such data may include the owners of social media platforms (the processing and protection of personal data are carried out in accordance with the rules established by those platforms) in connection with their dissemination on Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube profiles managed by the Organizer and the Prize Partners. Participants have the right to request from the Controller access to their personal data, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, and data portability, in the cases specified in the GDPR provisions.
7. Personal data may be disclosed to entities authorized under applicable law and to other entities to the extent necessary for the proper organization of the Competition. They may also be shared for publishing purposes or for publication on third-party platforms, provided that the photographs and videos in such third-party publications may only illustrate information about the activities carried out by the Organizers, and their use in any other context is not permitted.
8. Personal data will be processed for the period and to the extent necessary to achieve the stated purposes, i.e. for the conduct and promotion of the Competition, as well as for the organization and publication of post-competition materials. After the Competition has ended, the data will be processed for the duration of the exercise of ownership rights and economic copyrights in relation to the submitted works; thereafter, for the period and to the extent required by law or for the purpose of establishing, asserting, or defending potential claims
9. If consent is not withdrawn before the competition is concluded, the processing of the participant's personal data, to the extent necessary for the publication of results and for the publication and use of the submitted works by the Administrators, will be based on the Administrators' legitimate interest.
10. To the extent and subject to exceptions provided for by law, including the GDPR, Participants have the right to access their personal data, to rectify them, to request their erasure, to restrict their processing, to data portability, to object to processing, and to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in the event of a breach of personal data protection regulations.
11. The data will not be processed in an automated manner, including profiling.
